### **Enrollment and Participation**

- You may register via the website by submitting the completed online registration form at https://www.asser.academy/register/CTSP2022
- 2. Each participant should use a separate form.
- 3. Upon completion of the online registration form, you will be directed to an online payment environment.
- 4. Your place in the training programme is confirmed only when the online registration form has been submitted and the payment has been received.
- 5. The registration form constitutes a legally binding agreement. By submitting the completed registration form the registrant declares to be in accordance with the requirements and provisions described therein.
- The T.M.C. Asser Instituut cannot be held responsible for the non-arrival of registration information. If you have not received confirmation of your registration within 24 hours of submitting, please contact <u>educationtraining@asser.nl</u>.
- 7. The T.M.C. Asser Instituut reserves the right to withhold registration.
- 8. After successful attendance of the programme, a certificate of completion will be provided.

#### Fees and Payment Conditions T.M.C. Asser Instituut

- 1. There are three fee categories:
  - PhD student fee: €1045,-. A reduced fee has been made available for PhD candidates.
  - Early bird fee professionals (limited availability): €1395,-
  - Regular fee professionals: €1695,-
  - The fee includes lectures, study materials\*, study visit(s), refreshments, and welcome drinks.
- 2. You will only be secured of a place in the training programme once the T.M.C. Asser Instituut has received your <u>payment in</u> full.
- 3. Participants are responsible for the cost of all international travel, accommodation, evening meals (approximately €30 per day), and if applicable, any visa charges and medical insurance. The T.M.C. Asser Instituut can provide prospective participants with a list of suitable hotels in The Hague (€70-120 per day).

## **Cancellation Policy**

- 1. Cancellations will only be accepted when your request for cancellation is submitted by e-mail to educationtraining@asser.nl.
- 2. You have the right to withdraw your participation within 14 days of completing the payment, and the full sum paid will be reimbursed.
- 3. Once the abovementioned 14-day withdrawal period has expired, if you cancel less than four weeks prior to the starting date of the Training Programme, no refund of the course fee will be given.
- 4. Once the abovementioned 14-day withdrawal period has expired, if you cancel within the allotted time (at least 4 weeks before the starting date of the course), a processing fee of €250 will be charged. The remaining sum will be refunded.
- 5. The T.M.C Asser Instituut reserves the right to cancel the Training Programme. In the event that such action is necessary, registrants will be informed at least four weeks in advance of the starting date of the programme.
- 6. In the event that the T.M.C. Asser Instituut cancels the Training Programme, the full sum paid will be reimbursed.
- 7. The T.M.C Asser Instituut reserves the right to change the format of the Training Programme to online.
- 8. In the event the format of the Training Programme is changed to online, a discount of 33% on the tuition fee will be given. You will be reimbursed the difference if you had already paid the tuition fee in full.
